Our school is in the middle of Volos.



History of our school!

Our school belongs to the Greek state and was founded in 1980 and has been operating since then at the place where it is today. Its original name was 38th Elementary School of Volos, but twenty years later it was renamed 19th Elementary School of Volos.





History of our school!



It is housed in two separate buildings. The building that now houses most classrooms was built in 2002. Until that year, classrooms on the opposite side of the courtyard were used. These do not exist today. The building that now houses the dining room and the Integration Department has existed since 1955.

History of our school!

In the first years of its operation, students attended lessons either in the morning or in the afternoon. About a thousand students attended all these years at our school. Over the years, the students' population has been growing each school year. Today, our school has 118 students and their number is gradually declining due to the general low birth rate.





The classes and the playground




Our school isn't big. There are 6 basic classrooms and some more such as: a library which has got lots of books (photo), a teachers' office and a computer room with 20 computers in it.

There is also a dining room for "allday" school, a store room and a classroom which is used for the education of children with special needs. The playground is quite big (photo). There are lots of trees in this and it can be used for playing basketball and football by the children.

Our school is co-located with the 14th Primary School of Volos. In the same area and a few meters away there is a Kindergarten, a Primary School for kids with special needs, a Lyceum and the Music High School of our city.

The school year starts on 1^{st} September and ends on 21^{st} June of the next year. Lessons start on 11^{th} September up to 15^{th} June of the next year.




Every two years the school organizes a visit to the Greek Parliament in Athens.


